This office is in receipt of your claim in the amount of \$1,099.26, relating to the loss of a refund/tax credit on November 15, 2000 that you allege is owed to you by the City of Milwaukee for a property you previously owned at 1005 West Maple Street.

The Milwaukee Water Works records indicate you requested that the Water Works credit be applied to the delinquent property taxes that were on this property. The City Treasurer indicated they applied the credit on December 6, 2000 to your outstanding 2000 taxes.
