
**Re: File No. 130189, Resolution relating to a Certificate of Appropriateness for the complete exterior restoration/reconstruction of 2732-2734 W. Burnham Street in the American System-Built Historic District for the Frank Lloyd Wright Wisconsin Heritage Tourism Program, Inc.**

At a public hearing held on Monday, June 10, 2013, the Historic Preservation Commission, by a vote of six (6) ayes, zero (0) noes, and one (1) excused, granted a Certificate of Appropriateness for the complete exterior restoration/reconstruction of 2732-2734 W. Burnham Street, in accordance with the provisions of Section 320-21-11 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.

Upon granting of a certificate, Commission Staff shall issue a Certificate of Appropriateness. In the case of conditional granting of a certificate, the certificate shall only be issued upon your acceptance of the conditions placed on issuance of the certificate by the Commission.
