If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 08/26/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a shooting at 4623 W. Burleigh Street (Alghrouz Grocery). Investigation revealed the victim had been shot while in the parking lot of the business. Milwaukee police incident report #152380131 filed.
2. On 03/17/2017 Milwaukee police conducted follow up at 4326 W. Burleigh Street (Alghrouz Grocery) regarding convenience store robbery deterrence training. The officer detected a strong odor of tobacco and advised the manager, Jamal Jihad, of the no smoking ordinance. The officer also advised the manager of the next robbery deterrence training on 04/06/2017.
3. On 03/29/2017 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 4326 W. Burleigh (Alghrouz Grocery). Officers detected a strong odor of cigarette smoke that grew stronger as they approached the cashier area. They also observed an ashtray with 2 burned cigarettes. The cashier, Jamal Sood, admitted to the offense and stated he was aware he was not supposed to smoke in the store. The applicant was cited.

-This report was written by P.O. Brian LaROQUE, assigned to District Seven, Late Power Shift. On Wednesday, August 26, 2015 at 6:50pm Squad 7450 (P.O. Blake KASBERGER and I) responded to 4623 W Burleigh St (Alghrouz Grocery) for a shooting complaint. Upon our arrival we secured the scene and observed blood in the parking lot of the business.

The manger at the business, Suhayb S ABUASI, allowed us immediate access to the video system, which allowed us to get a description of the suspects broadcasted to other officers in the area. It was determined that the victim was in the parking lot of the business and that he was approached by an unknown subject and a physical fight in sued between the two subjects. Both subjects were armed with handguns and the suspect shot the victim at close range and continued to fight with the victim. A second actor appeared and also started to physically attack the victim.

The victim had his firearm and U.S. Currency taken from him after he was shot. The victim suffered a serious gunshot wound and required surgery. This is the second shooting that occurred in the parking lot of this business in the last 4 calendar days.





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## Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.  
**Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.**

The earliest date that the Common Council may be able to consider your renewal and that the license may be issued is July 11, 2017.

A current license must be issued and posted on the premises at all times. **Therefore, you may not operate as a food dealer establishment after June 30, 2017.** Your food dealer business may only resume after the Licenses Committee and Common Council has considered and granted your renewal application.
