REASON FOR REQUEST:

Peter Ulatowski, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment and a passenger in a City of Milwaukee police vehicle that was traveling eastbound on West Lincoln Avenue. As the City vehicle entered the intersection of West Windlake Avenue and West Lincoln Avenue, the uninsured motorist, who was intoxicated, was traveling southwest on West Windlake Avenue and failed to yield the right-of-way by disregarding the flashing red traffic signal, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Ulatowski sustained lacerations and bruises to head, a right knee injury, and a fractured left ankle requiring surgery. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$71,025.94.
