REASON FOR REQUEST:

Gregory Simerlein, a City of Milwaukee Police Officer, was in the scope of his employment and operating a City of Milwaukee Police vehicle that was traveling northbound in the right lane of North Teutonia Avenue. As the City vehicle began to pull over to let out a conveyance who was in the rear of the City vehicle, the uninsured motorist, who was proceeding southbound on North Teutonia Avenue, was traveling too fast for conditions (snow) and lost control of his vehicle and spun into northbound traffic, colliding with the City vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to §62.67 Stats., and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Simerlein sustained injuries to his neck, back, left shoulder and pelvis. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages, including the subrogated lien of WPS, total \$12,267.30.
