If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. This report was submitted by Police Officer Rafael LOPEZ assigned to District 6, Late Shift, as Squad 6330, along with Police Officer Benjamin SCHAFFHAUSE.

During this call for service, we were in full Milwaukee Police Department uniform with our badge and last names affixed to our out most garment and equipped with an AXON body worn camera which was activated during the course of the investigation. We were also operating marked Milwaukee Police Department squad #627 with functional red and blue emergency lights and audible siren also equipped with an AXON camera system.

On Saturday, June 20, 2025, at approximately 11:51 a.m., Squad 6420 (Police Officer Leslie TORRES) and we (Squad 6330) were dispatched to the address of 3675 S. 13th St., which is the 13th Pour Tavern located in the City and County of Milwaukee for a Subject with a weapon later changed to a Battery call for service.

Upon arrival, we were met by the bartender Chloe S. HENN (w/f, 10-5-99) who stated that 2 unknown suspects walked into the establishment and began to argue with a customer sitting at the bar area and then a fight ensued between the customer and the 2 unknown suspects. Another customer identified as Juan ALVAREZ (w/m, 8-3-1978) was sitting next to the customer that was assaulted and tried to break up the fight. During the fight ALVAREZ was punched on the upper eye causing a golf ball size injury. ALVAREZ denied medical attention on scene and stated if need be he would seek medical attention later.

Suspect #1 described as a black male in his early 30's, 6'02" tall, skinny build, wearing all black clothing.

Both suspects and the other customer that was assaulted left the scene prior to police arrival.

The employees at the above listed establishment were cooperative during our investigation.

No surveillance video reviewed due to HENN not having access to the video surveillance device.

While on scene, I observed the license posted and it was up to date. During my investigation I did not observe any violations in the licensed premise.

Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
