

EXPERIENCE

CULTURAL VILLAGE

Immerse yourself in Irish art, literature, history, and theater! Meet authors at the Literary Corner, shop the artisans at Moore Street Market, explore Irish history exhibits, learn simple Gaelic phrases from Irish language experts, meet with genealogists and discover your Irish roots in the Genealogy area, and catch the new play, *Galway Girl*, in the Theatre Pavilion.

SHOPPING

Explore one of the largest gatherings of Irish vendors in the world, with more than 90 vendors dispersed throughout the grounds. Shop authentic Irish crafts and retail items, and visit our Milwaukee Irish Fest store for an official souvenir.
