**Deadline to File a Complaint to Determine Dischargeability of Certain Debts: 11/24/08**

**Deadline to Object to Exemptions:**

Thirty (30) days after the conclusion of the meeting of creditors.

**Proposed Plan; Objection to Plan; Hearing on Confirmation of Plan**

If a plan has been filed, a copy is enclosed. If not, you will receive it at a later date. If there is no written objection to the plan, the Court may confirm the plan. If a written **objection to confirmation** of the proposed plan is filed no later than ten days after the completion of the Meeting of Creditors, a **hearing** will be scheduled by the Court. The only persons who will be notified of the hearing date will be the trustee, counsel for the debtor (or the debtor if the debtor is not represented by counsel), the Office of the United States Trustee, the objecting party, and all other persons who specifically request in writing to receive notice.

**Creditors May Not Take Certain Actions:**

In most instances, the filing of a bankruptcy case automatically stays certain collections and other actions against the debtor, the debtor's property, and certain codebtors. Under certain circumstances, the stay may be limited to 30 days, or not exist at all; although the debtor can request the court to extend or impose a stay. If you attempt to collect a debt or take other action in violation of the Bankruptcy Code, you may be penalized. Consult a lawyer to determine your rights in this case.
