



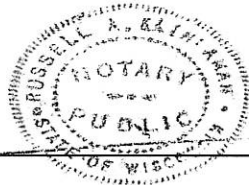

Substitute resolution approving levying of assessments and construction of assessable public improvement projects at various locations and appropriating funds for these purposes with the City cost of these projects approved by this resolution is estimated to be \$723,200 for a total estimated cost of \$786,200.

Whereas, The Common Council of the City of Milwaukee adopted preliminary resolutions, determining it necessary and in the public interest to construct and levy special assessments for the following improvements:

**N. 64th St. -- W. Hampton Ave. to W. Villard Ave. (ST211180226).** Install traffic calming speed hump(s). (Assessable Reconstruction Paving Fund - \$27,500; Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund - \$500). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$28,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2018 construction season.

**5th Aldermanic District**  
**W. Metcalf Pl.-N. 97th St. to N. 100th St. (ST211180120).** File Number 170391: Asphalt pavement resurfacing, replace curb and gutter, sidewalk and driveway approaches where necessary, sodding (9' width of tree border area), and grading. (Assessable Reconstruction Paving Fund - \$17,000; Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund - 245,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$285,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2018-19 construction season.
