AN ACT to amend 119.04 (1); and to create 120.26 of the statutes; relating to:

prohibiting school boards from imposing residency requirements on teachers.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits a school board from requiring, as a condition of employment, that a teacher reside within the school district.
