Dear Mr. Mahan:

As you are aware, Silver Spring Neighborhood Center (SSNC) and the Havenwoods Economic Development Corporation (HEDC) have decided to end their relationship with respect to the funding from the City of Milwaukee Community Development Block Grants Program for community organizing/crime awareness prevention/neighborhood strategic planning.

The SSNC Board of Directors approved this action at its regularly scheduled board meeting held on November 18, 2009. As a result of this action, the employment of Stephanie Harling, Liz Hammer and Laqueshia Turner with SSNC will be terminated as of the close of business on December 31, 2009. It is the understanding of SSNC that following their termination from SSNC they will become formally employed by HEDC.

Therefore, beginning January 1, 2010, funding for community organizing/crime awareness prevention/neighborhood strategic planning for NSP Area 2 should be made directly to the HEDC.

SSNC will continue to work closely with the HEDC in making the Northwest side a safer, stronger neighborhood and community.
