Dear Alderperson Coggs,

I live in Riverwest and have owned a home on the 3300 block of Booth Street since 1999. Over the years, since Family Dollar opened on Concordia and Holton, we in the neighborhood have complained to their management and staff, and to the aldermanic office, about the garbage generated and poorly managed by their store--flying all over our neighborhood. Today, as I was out walking my dog, I again went into the store and around to the loading dock to ask them to please keep the lids to their recycling and garbage closed so that garbage wasn't flying out in the wind. They claimed that the garbage in our yards "could not possibly be from our store", but as the man said that to me today, I looked down at the ground between his feet and mine, at their loading dock, next to their garbage and recycling bins all with the lids wide open... and it was covered with loose garbage, Family dollar plastic bags, packaging of all kinds, blowing around.

Their garbage containers behind their store are often overflowing or have the lids wide open allowing garbage to fly up the Beerline trail bike path and up Booth Street into our yards. They consistently make a big mess unloading their trucks and leave loose garbage flying. We pick up garbage from them daily in fairly large quantities in our yard, in the yards of neighbors, along the trail (the trail is a wonderful addition to the neighborhood--but the garbage accumulating undermines that effort).

Why is it that when we had some blooming chickory growing around a tree in front of our house we were cited and fined for weeds, but they can persist in creating large quantities of garbage that are unhealthy, ugly and a product of their irresponsible presence in our neighborhood? Is there anything that you can do as Alderperson to get Family Dollar to better contain their garbage, and perhaps take some responsibility for cleaning up when it spills? If that store was on Downer Avenue I seriously doubt that they would allow that kind of negative contribution to the neighborhood.

If businesses are to be attracted to a neighborhood like Riverwest and Harambee, they need to be responsible partners in helping to make it a better place. Corporate businesses that take money from us, without

contributing back...in fact bringing the neighborhood down several notches in quality of life by creating garbage in our yards and parks...have no place in Riverwest or Harambee.







This report is written by Police Officer KUKOWSKI, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 08/21/14, Milwaukee police conducted a business check at 400 E Burleigh after observing numerous subjects standing in front of the business loitering. This location has received numerous complaints for loitering, drug dealing, subjects with guns, etc. There is a standard complaint form for no loitering at this business which has been ordered by the property owner, Sue Lee, and signs are clearly posted in the windows of the stores. Police observed a subject loitering in front of the business and conducted a field interview. This subject was identified as Jason Randolph and advised police he worked at the location. Police wanted to confirm his employment and spoke to the clerk, identified as Saed Abdelsalam, who was located behind the counter. Abdelsalam stated that Randolph was an employee and that he stocks food goods. During this investigation, officers observed Randolph continually walking in and out of the front door, loitering with other subjects outside. Police never observed Randolph performing any stocking duties. A wanted check revealed Randolph has two cash bail only warrants and police attempted to arrest Randolph who resisted arrest. Police later spoke with owner/licensee Akran A Sharqawi, who confirmed that Randolph was a part time employee. Sharqawi was asked to appear at District Five on 08/27/14 at 12:00 pm, for a meeting with CPU officers regarding the loitering and drug dealing complaints outside his establishment.

2. On 08/27/14, Akran Sharqawi met with members of the Milwaukee Police Department, City Attorney's Office, Department of Neighborhood Services and the business building owner Sukin Lee. Sujin Lee signed an updated Standing Complaint form and police provided two "No Loitering" signs to be posted on her building. Lee advised police that she applied for a City of Milwaukee grant to install surveillance cameras on the exterior of her building. Police spoke with Sharqawi in regards to the arrest of Randolph and that Sharqawi might need to evaluate if he will keep Randolph on as an employee. Also discussed were ways to abate nuisance activity. Police hand delivered an 80-10 Chronic Nuisance letter to Sharqawi and a copy was also given to Sukin Lee. CPU officers from District Five did coordinate the Project Impact armed vehicle, which is equipped with video surveillance, to be parked across the street from the store from 8/27/14 - 08/29/14. Both Lee and Sharqawi were supportive of this action. Sharqawi is required to submit a written plan of action that will address nuisance activity to his store to District Five by September 11, 2014.

Present at this meeting were the following people: ADA Jake Corr, ACA Nick DeSiato, Kelly O'Neill, DNS Jason Rusnak, PO Michael Walker, PO Cory Lopez, PO Laurel Lammers, Sujin Lee (owner of building) and Akram Sharqawi (licensee of store)

Owner (Sujin Lee) signed an updated Standing Complaint form with District Five. Lee was provided with two "No Loitering" Signs to post on her building. Lee stated she did apply for a City of Milwaukee grant to install Surveillance cameras on the exterior of her building. Kelly O'Neill from Safe and Sound offered her assistance with applying for this program.

CPU officers spoke with SHARQAWI regarding arrest of employee Jason RANDOLPH last week. SHARQAWI stated he was going to address this problem with RANDOLPH and evaluate if he will keep RANDOLPH on as an employee. The following items were also discussed with SHARQAWI as ways to abate nuisance activity at his store.

· Hiring a licensed security company to monitor location.

Perform better employee screenings.

Call police for help with loitering problem outside of store.

Not handing out free items to get unwanted patrons to move along.

PO Lammers hand delivered an 80-10 Chronic Nuisance letter to SHARQAWI. A copy was also given building owner (Sukin Lee).

CPU officers at District Five did coordinate the Project Impact armed vehicle (Rhino), which is equipped with video surveillance, to be parked across the street from the store from 8/27/14 to 8/29/14. Both Lee and SHARQAWI were supportive of this action.

SHARQAWI is required to submit a written plan of action that will address nuisance activity at his store to District Five by September 11, 2014.

This report is being written by P.O. Michael WALKER, assigned to District Five Squad 5264 with P.O. C LOPEZ. On Thursday, August 21, 2014, we along with squad 5246 (PO Steven Rufus and PO Phillip PO conducted a business check of 400 E. Burleigh Street (Burleigh Food Store) after observing numerous substanding in front of the business loitering. This location has numerous complaints for loitering, drug deali subjects with guns, etc. There is a Standing Complaint form for no loitering at this particular location whi has been ordered by the property owner, Sue Lee w/f 01/29/69, and the signs are clearly posted in the wince of the store.

PO LOPEZ interviewed one of the subjects, later identified as Jason M. RANDOLPH, B/M 05/08/86, who was observed loitering in front of the location. RANDOLPH stated he worked at the location. Due to all one loitering, officers conducted a business check of the location and wanted to confirm his employment. PO LOPEZ requested identification from RANDOLPH and he complied. PO LOPEZ then interviewed the storage clerk, Saed M. ABDELSALAM W/M 07-06-71, who was located at the main counter behind a partition. ABDELSALAM stated he just came from Chicago and has been working at the location for 4 to 5 days. ABDELSALAM stated that RANDOLPH does work at the location stocking food goods. I was outside of the store investigating another incident prior to officers making contact with RANDOLPH. During this time I observed RANDOLPH continually walking in and out of the front door of the store, loitering with other subjects outside. I never observed RANDOLPH performing any stocking duties during this time.

A wanted check was conducted the subjects that were loitering, including RANDOLPH. At that time RANDOLPH came back with two Cash Bail Only warrants for his arrest. At that time PO LOPEZ advised RANDOLPH to place his hands behind his back. RANDOLPH crossed his arms in front of him and stated why. PO LOPEZ told RANDOLPH he was under arrest for his warrants. PO LOPEZ opened the front door the store and requested additional officer to come in due to RANDOLPH's demeanor, and the fact that he warrefusing to place his hands behind his back.

At that time RANDOLPH did intentionally resist arrest by clenching his fists, actively pulling his arms and body away from officers when they attempted to place him into handcuff restraints. RANDOLPH was given numerous commands to STOP RESISTING, but refused officers lawful commands. RANDOLPH repeatedly yelled, "I won't until you tell me what my warrants are for". It took four Police Officers: POs LOPEZ, WALKER, RUFUS and POULUS, two of which had to perform focused knee strikes, to overcome RANDOLPH active resistance in order place him into handcuff restraints. RANDOLPH continued to be aggressive and uncooperative with officers after being placed in custody.

Sgt Rochelle GAWAIN responded to the scene and investigated the use of force regarding this arrest. Sgt. GAWIN interviewed ABDELSALAM who stated that he did not see what occurred because he was helping a customer at the time. This incident did occur in front of the main store counter that ABDELSALAN was standing behind. ABDELSALAM was approximately 8 to10 feet away from us during this entire inciden The incident was captured on the store's video and Sgt. GAWIN filed a form to have the Identification Division retrieve the video.

RANDOLPH was later conveyed to District Five by squad 5290 (PO Willie SWIMS) for booking and processing. RANDOLPH was charged with Resisting an Officer (946.41). See related Milwaukee Police Department Incident # 14-233-0139.

On Sunday, August 24, 2014 at 1:45 pm I made contact with the owner/licensee of this establishment, Akran . SHARQAWI (W/M 12/16/73), 324-3279, who confirmed RANDOLPH was part-time employee. I requested that SHARQAWI come into District Five on Wednesday, August 27, 2014 at 12:00 pm for a meeting with CP officers regarding Loitering and Drug Dealing complaints outside his establishment.
