This is to notify you that on February 18, 2003 the City's Utilities and Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council that your renewal application for a Class "B" Tavern license be granted and that the Tavern Amusement (Cabaret/Nite Club) portion of the license be denied for the premises located at 1243 West Vliet Street ("Caribbean Culture Club & Restaurant"). 
