File #001398 is a resolution authorizing the Milwaukee Fire Department to accept thermal imaging cameras donated by the Kiwanis Club of Milwaukee Foundation Inc.

Background & Discussion

- 1. The Kiwanis Club of Milwaukee Foundation Inc. is currently engaged in a fundraising effort to raise money to purchase thermal imaging cameras for the Milwaukee Fire Department.
- 2. The cameras will assist the Department's fire fighting efforts by gauging the location and intensity of a fire from outside a burning building, piercing through smoke to find fire victims and identifying "hot spots" inside walls of buildings.
- 3. The initial goal of the project is to raise enough money to purchase 8 cameras. (6 for the Department's Battalion Chiefs, 1 for the Deputy Chief and 1 for the Heavy Urban Rescue Team.) The ultimate goal is purchase 10 additional cameras (1 for each ladder company), for a total of 18.
- 4. Each camera costs approximately \$18,000.

Fiscal Impact

The resolution has no fiscal impact.
