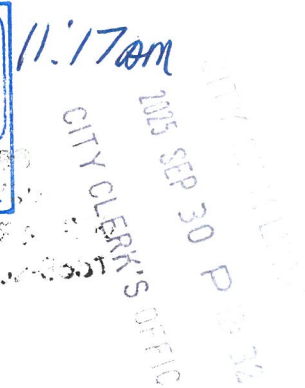
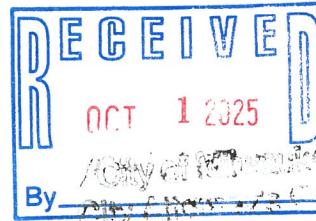

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, pursuant to §893.80, Wis. Stats., that on August 19, 2025, Lashawn Johnson (hereinafter referred to as "Mr. Johnson") was a back seat passenger in a 2007 Ford Focus that was owned by Jose Enrique Pabon Vega and operated by Arthur E. Sikisi. Mr. Sikisi was traveling eastbound on West Mineral Street at a high rate of speed as it was being chased for approximately four (4) miles by a Milwaukee Police Department squad car. Mr. Sikisi lost control of the vehicle, hit a parked car, and then hit a tree.

Mr. Johnson suffered significant injuries including internal bleeding and a broken left femur which required surgical repair. Ms. Johnson has medical bills and lost wages that exceed \$250,000.00. The Milwaukee Police Department negligently and recklessly chased the vehicle with a complete disregard for other motorists and the passengers in the vehicle. Officer John Doe



of the Milwaukee Police Department violated explicit policy not to chase in the circumstance surrounding the subject crash.

Liability for Mr. Johnson's injuries and damages are attributed to the City of Milwaukee, Officer John Doe and the City of Milwaukee Police Department. Mr. Johnson suffered severe physical injuries as a result of the Milwaukee Police Department's negligence. Damages for these injuries clearly exceed the \$250,000.00 statutory liability cap and demand for payment of that statutory \$250,000.00 cap is hereby made; supporting documentation will be provided of his injuries.
