Dear Mr. Leonhardt:

Please be advised that I represent Police Officer Lamont Hodnett. Officer Hodnett was charged by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office with First Degree Reckless Injury - While Armed in Case No. 98CF002560. That case was litigated through jury trial and Officer Hodnett was found not guilty.


Officer Hodnett testified during the trial, and in his statements to the police, that he was acting in his capacity as a Milwaukee Police Officer at the time this incident occurred. Officer Hodnett was off duty at the time of the incident, but placed himself back on duty, given the dangerous activity which he observed and felt he had a duty to quell. He further testified at the trial that after stopping the driver of the vehicle who was conducting the dangerous activity, a third party injected himself into the situation, drew a weapon and prepared to fire at Officer Hodnett at which time Officer Hodnett fired in self-defense. As indicated above, the jury found Officer Hodnett not guilty.

Based upon my representation of Officer Hodnett, claim is hereby made on his behalf for the indicated legal fees which are attached and which I provided to Officer Hodnett in his defense of this matter. I have been advised by the City Attorney's Office that in the event this claim is granted, it would be paid at the rate of \$110.00 per hour. While that is well below my usual fee, I have presented the bill at that rate.

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It is my understanding that the City Attorney's Office refused to represent Officer Hodnett regardless of the fact that he was performing duties of his office at the time of the events giving rise to this incident.
