There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to attend this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants and partnership applicants must attend or attend by an attorney. The agent or attorney for corporate or limited liability applicants must attend. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition attend the virtual hearing and are willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should request an interpreter attend the meeting with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

This report is written by Police Officer David NOVAK, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 02/22/2014 Milwaukee police responded to a Trouble with a Subject complaint at 10155 West Appleton Avenue (Midpoint Motel). During the investigation, officers noticed the posted licenses and permits were not current. The applicant explained that the current licenses were posted at a different location. The applicant was told to post the most current licenses at this location.
- 2. On 12/29/2019 officers were dispatched to Mid Point Motel, 10155 W. Appleton Av, for a Property Damage call. The officers interviewed the clerk who stated a subject came in and asked for the key for room 15. When the subject could not provide ID to prove he rented the room the clerk turned him away. The subject then went to room 15 and kicked in the door. The officer located the subject who rented the room and he admitted to calling a female subject he knows to be a prostitute and having her meet him at the room. The officers were able to obtain a copy of the video of the incident.
- 3. On 07/29/2021 at 2:06am officers were dispatched to an Overdose at Mid Point Motel, 10155 W. Appleton Av. When officer arrived the victim had been transported by ambulance to the

hospital and the caller was no longer on scene. The officers located paraphernalia in the room for using drugs.

### **INITIAL INVESTIGATION**

This report was submitted by P.O. O'Shay SATHE. I am currently assigned to District 4, Late Shift, Squad 4320, with P.O. Austin GRABOWSKI.

On Thursday, July 29th, 2021, at approximately 2:06 AM, myself and PO GRABOWSKI (While in full duty uniform, wearing an Axon Body Worn Camera, and operating a marked MPD squad car) were dispatched to an "overdose" complaint at 10155 W Appleton Av #20 (Mid Point Motel), which is in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI.

The overdose was called in by a subject who was with the victim, Daniel A WATKINS (W/M, 08/16/72), who was no longer on scene upon MFD arrival. MFD Engine 4, Green Shift, LT MCCARTHY was on scene. Med Unit 16, Green Shift, Acting LT VASQUEZ transported WATKINS to St Joseph's Hospital.

WATKINS was already transported to St Josephs Hospital upon our arrival. I entered the hotel room that WATKINS was in and observed a clear pipe on the bed and a used hypodermic needle on the floor near the bathroom. The pipe had burn marks on the ends of it, and due to my training and experience involving drugs, I determined that the pipe was used for smoking crack cocaine. Upon searching the rest of the hotel, I discovered a small metal pipe in the drawer of the night stand, which I determined to be used for either smoking or snorting drugs.



The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 06/28/2022 at 01:20 PM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
