Dear Mr. Stace:

This is to notify you that on May 18, 2006 the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council that your renewal application for a Visual and Performing Arts classification for the premises located at 2844 North Oakland Avenue ("Miramar Theatre") be revoked based upon a complaint filed by Ronald Roberts.

On May 19, 2006 you were sent a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to your renewal application for a Visual and Performing Arts classification for the premises located at 2844 North Oakland Avenue ("Miramar Theatre"), recommending revocation. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of May 31, 2006 commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of your right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time and place you did not appear, but you did file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee. You were not represented by counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee and your objections, the Common Council returned this matter to the Licenses Committee for further proceedings by a vote of fourteen (14) Ayes, zero (0) Noes and one (1) Excused. Your revocation hearing before the Licenses Committee has now been scheduled for 8 a.m. on Tuesday, June 6<sup>th</sup> in Room 301-B of the Milwaukee City Hall.
