Community Schools Nationally

- Community Schools is a national model with a proven record of success
 - Cincinnati: Highest performing urban district in state, grad rates went from 51% to 80%, black and white achievement gap went from 14.5% to 4%
 - Tulsa: Economically disadvantaged students scoring on par with middle-class peers
 - Portland: Community Schools met or exceeded academic benchmarks

MCSP Timeline

- Adopted in January of 2015 in Milwaukee
 - Started with four MPS schools
 - Initial four Coordinators hired by United Way
- Added three new schools in July 2016
 - Coordinators were hired by Partner Agencies
- Planning to add one new school in 2017-18
