Dear Mr. Lewis:

We have received your claim for the amount of \$3,626.59 in relation to the vehicle damage you sustained on August 24, 2017 near North Hopkins Street and West Villard Avenue.


Our investigation determined that the City vehicle was traveling northbound on North Hopkins Street. You were traveling north on Hopkins Street attempting to make a left turn. The City vehicle moved to the right to go around your vehicle when you suddenly decided to make a right turn striking our vehicle. Based on this information, it appears you are the proximate cause of the accident.

The damage to your vehicle was not the result of any negligence of the City of Milwaukee. Therefore, the City is not legally liable for your damage. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a written statement requesting a hearing within 21 days of the postmarked date of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202. Please include a photocopy of this letter's envelope, showing the postmark, and retain the original in the event further proof is needed.
