File No. 010530 is a resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of a Wisconsin Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Funding Assistance Program grant. (Fire Department)

Background and Discussion

1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Fire Department to apply for, accept and fund a Wisconsin Emergency Medical Services Program from the State of Wisconsin's Department of Health and Family Services.
2. The Milwaukee Fire Department provides EMS to the citizens and visitors of the City.
3. The grant will be used to assist the Milwaukee Fire Department (an EMS provider) in enhancing the provision of emergency medical services through purchase of EMS supplies, equipment and training.
4. The total amount of the grant is \$44,721. The City will contribute \$14,721 in the form of an in-kind contribution of indirect costs.
5. The Grantor's \$30,000 share will be used to purchase emergency medical services supplies (\$25,000) and emergency medical equipment (\$5,000).
6. The grant will be in operation from July 1, 2001 to June 30, 2002.

Fiscal Impact

1. The resolution authorizes the acceptance of and the expenditure of \$44,721 (\$30,000 from Wisconsin Department of Health and Family Services and \$14,721 as the City's in-kind contribution) from the Grant and Aid account titled Wisconsin EMS Funding Assistance Program grant.
