File No. 010530 is a resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of a Wisconsin Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Funding Assistance Program grant. (Fire Department)

Background and Discussion

- This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Fire Department to apply for, accept and fund a Wisconsin Emergency Medical Services Program from the State of Wisconsin's Department of Health and Family Services.
- 2. The Milwaukee Fire Department provides EMS to the citizens and visitors of the City.
- 3. The grant will be used to assist the Milwaukee Fire Department (an EMS provider) in enhancing the provision of emergency medical services through purchase of EMS supplies, equipment and training.
- 4. The total amount of the grant is \$44,721. The City will contribute \$14,721 in the form of an in-kind contribution of indirect costs.
- 5. The Grantor's \$30,000 share will be used to purchase emergency medical services supplies (\$25,000) and emergency medical equipment (\$5,000).
- 6. The grant will be in operation from July 1, 2001 to June 30, 2002.

Fiscal Impact

1. The resolution authorizes the acceptance of and the expenditure of \$44,721 (\$30,000 from Wisconsin Department of Health and Family Services and \$14,721 as the City's in-kind contribution) from the Grant and Aid account titled Wisconsin EMS Funding Assistance Program grant.
