
We have received your claim in the amount of \$1,300.00, relating to damage to your wet concrete which you allege had been caused by a City employee who was inserting recycling schedules on a cart on April 4, 2012 and had walked on the concrete at your residence at 7449 North 90th Street.

Our investigation reveals that the Sanitation Section report completed as a result of this alleged incident notes that there is no conclusive evidence that the City caused the damage. As such, the City cannot accept liability. Therefore, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days of the receipt of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
