

## AMENDMENT No. 1 to Friends of Housing Corporation - Agreement for Property Management of Scattered Sites Residential Buildings (Contract No. 16-030 (CM))

This Amendment ("Amendment") is dated as of November 1, 2019 (the "Effective Date"), and is by and between the City of Milwaukee ("CITY") and Friends of Housing Corporation, a domestic non-stock corporation existing under the laws of the State of Wisconsin ("FOH"). The parties, for good and valuable consideration, receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged, agree as follows.

## RECITALS

- A. FOH and City are parties to an "Agreement for Property Management of Scattered Sites Residential Buildings" dated November 1, 2016 (the "Contract") (No. 16-030), authorized by the City's Common Council in Resolution File No. 151197.
- B. Per Contract Section 3(A) of the contract the term of the contract commenced on the Commencement Date and terminates three (3) years after the Commencement Date.
- C. FOH and City now enter this Amendment No. 1 to acknowledge the term extension to continue the property management services under the contract
- D. Capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Contract.

## WHEREFORE

- 1. Term Extended. The contract term is now extended to expire on November 1, 2020.
- 2. Other Contract Terms Unaffected. Except as expressly amended hereby, all other terms and conditions of the Contract remain in full force and effect.
- 3. <u>Counterparts</u>. This Amendment may be executed in one or more counterparts which, when taken together, shall constitute one and the same document. Facsimile and/or email-PDF copies of signatures shall be accepted as originals.
