Your email has been received. From the photo provided, this food truck is legally parked if outside of the posted hours of 2am-6pm and if they are moving every 6hrs. Your understanding of the ordinance is correct and impressive. You probably won't like that the City does not currently have a "Block Face Ordinance" which would require vehicles to move off of the block face after parking for the allotted time therefore, the moving of the truck a few feet does constitute moving the vehicle. Please request the block face ordinance via your Alderpersons Office if interested. Since you have brought this to our attention, Parking Enforcement will increase patrols in this area. Ald. Bauman,

A food truck (Taquria El Tizne) has been parking along the west side of Young St. at Catalano Square for over three weeks, at least 6-7 days per week. It's taking advantage of the customers frequenting the popular Third Ward Beer Garden at Catalano Square.

In my tenure here in the Third Ward, we have rarely had issues with food trucks and vendors in the right of way.

So, I'm not totally up to speed on regulations including more recent changes made by the Common Council. But I believe they may be in violations of some ordinance provisions. I'll describe their general mode of operation below based on input we are getting from patrons and operators of the Beer Garden.

- 1. They arrive in mid-early AM and park in roughly the same spot each day (see night picture). The parking there is 2-HR time limits, no meters.
- 2. They've been observed parking personal vehicles on either side of the truck and moving the truck once in a while. I believe that's part of the ordinance to move every six hours and/or obey posted regulations.
- 3. They've been parked from 10am to 10pm on this face block on a regular basis.
- 4. The grass in the tree border (between sidewalk and curb) is showing signs of wear and tear due to foot traffic to the window. Who is responsible for repairing that damage?
- 5. We have created a welcoming nighttime ambiance for and with the Beer Garden via canopy lights in the trees. As you can see from the photo, they turn on garish lighting to not only draw attention to their truck but to light up the east portion of the park via their lights. Ugly.

Based on my reading of the City's food truck regs, I think they are in parking violation of the policies as written, if not to their intent. Moving it a few feet every couple of hours is not the intent of the ordinance.

My nearby bricks and mortar restaurants are not happy about this. Club Charlie's and Riley's Social House are nearby food options that are advertised at the Beer Garden for food patronage.

Thanks for your attention to this matter and I've cc'd I believe the relevant departments responsible for regulating food trucks. I look foward to hearing from you.

On Thursday, August 29, 2024, PO Molly PLUMLEY (Squad 1163), PO Joshua QUINONES-DAVILA (Squad 1233), and I (squad 1264) were dispatched to 147 N. Broadway for a food truck complaint.

Upon arrival PO QUINONES-DAVILA spoke to the owner of TAQUERIA EL TINZE food truck Jose Luis ANTUNEZ JIMENEZ (H/M 0909-18-1988) and explained to him in Spanish that the food truck ordinance is to move every two hours and must move at least six blocks away from the original parking space. ANTUNEZ JIMENEZ understood this ordinance, PO QUINONES-DAVILA also explained that a food peddlers' book of regulations can be obtained from city hall and encouraged ANTUNEZ JIMENEZ to obtain a copy. It was also explained to ANTUNEZ JIMENEZ that numerous businesses complained about the food truck being parked all day long and also noted the damage to the grass near the food truck.

ANTUNEZ JIMENEZ was provided a community contact card while on scene.

Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.

2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)

3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).

4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.

5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.) 6. You may then provide testimony.

a. Include only information relating to the above license application.

b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.

c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.

d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.

7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.

8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
