Regarding: Your Class A Malt and Food Dealer License Applications as  for "Hary Mini Mart LLC" for "Hary Mini Mart" at 2301 W HOPKINS St.

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

3. On 11-23-02, Ahmad Z. Abdulrahim, (same subject above, but listed with this spelling) who is a listed corporate officer, received citations for Driving with Person Riding Illegally and Racing on Highway in Milwaukee County.

4. On 03-21-03, Ahmad Abdel-Rahim, who is a listed corporate officer, was suspended for 6 months for a Blood Alcohol Concentration violation, which occurred on 02-19-03. No further information.

Applicant's name now appears as Elham M. Rahim per DOT, it appears that the applicant did not notify the License Division at City Hall. See scanned driver's license print out from DOT. Names should be corrected to ensure an accurate background check.

5. On 05/24/2013 Milwaukee police investigated the anonymous complaint that the store at 2301 West Hopkins Avenue is selling single cigarettes and purchasing illegal baby formula. Officers spoke to Mohammad Z. Abdelrahim who stated that no one in the store sells single cigarettes. No police reports or citations were written.
6. On 06/12/2013 Milwaukee police, along with Agent Erin Dorn of the Wisconsin Department of Revenue, conducted an inspection at 2301 West Hopkins Street (Family Supersaver). Agent Dorn confiscated over 300 packs of cigarettes that did not have a Fire Safety Code stamp, several individual cigarillos that were being sold outside their original containers and several packs of cigarillos for which there was no invoice. It was also discovered that there was no one on the premises with a valid Class D operator's license. Ahmad Z. Abdel-Rahim was issued citations for Sell Cigarettes in Package/Container without Stamp and Responsible Person on Premises Required. Both citations were later dismissed without prejudice.
7. On 03/10/2014 Milwaukee police officers conducted follow up at 2301 West Hopkins Street (Family Super Saver) regarding a complaint of single cigarette sales to minors. The cashier, Mohammed A. Ishtiwi, denied selling single cigarettes as well as selling cigarettes to minors. During this follow up, officers discovered that the business's licenses were not properly displayed. Officers advised Ishtiwi that the licenses need to be displayed, Ishtiwi indicated he understood and would comply.

8. On 10/15/2014 Milwaukee police assisted several other agencies, including the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Department of Justice, the Department of Homeland Security, the Wisconsin Department of Revenue, the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office, the City of Milwaukee Department of Neighborhood Services and the United States Department of Agriculture execute a search warrant at 2301 West Hopkins Street (Family Super Saver Foods). The search warrant was based on evidence the store was committing fraud utilizing the Quest and WIC programs. Approximately 27 boxes of evidence, including computer equipment, surveillance equipment, receipts, invoices, ledgers and tobacco were confiscated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation. This case is pending.

9. On 07/15/2017 a 17 year old working in conjunction with the Milwaukee Police Department and WI WINS Tobacco initiative, was able to purchase a 2 pack of Grape Swisher Sweet cigars from the clerk at Family Super Saver. The clerk was identified to be the agent, ELHAM RAHIM, who stated she did not remember the sale. She was advised she would receive a MARTS letter in the mail.

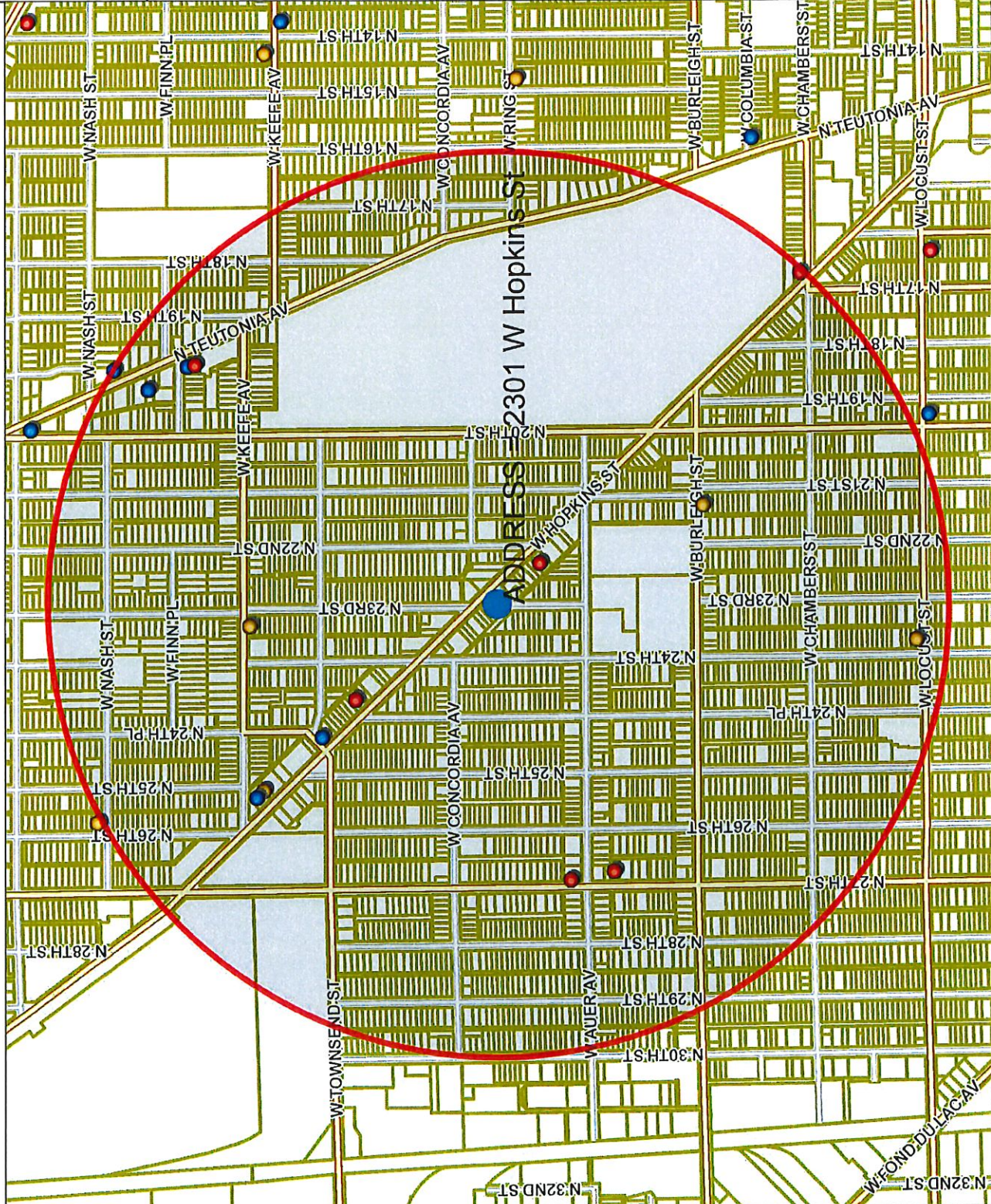



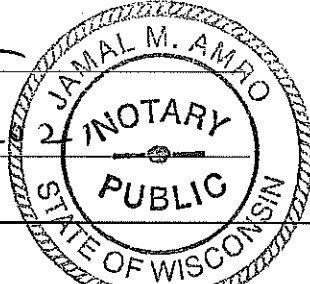
