Good Afternoon All,

I reached out to Cleveland, Kansas City, Detroit and Louisville with questions about their residential hiring programs earlier this year. Employees from Cleveland and Kansas City responded to my inquiry, but only Cleveland provided information on their resident hiring program.

Cleveland's program is monitored by the Mayor's Office of Equal Opportunity and is similar to RPP, however, they only require 20% resident participation and 4% low-income resident participation on contracts in excess of \$100,000.00. Detailed information on Cleveland's Resident Employment Law is attached along with the 2017 report from the Office of Equal Opportunity, an office that is tasked with monitoring both resident employment and SBE participation. Cleveland's report does not include information on demographics.
