
REASON FOR REQUEST:

Devion Phillips, a City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works employee, was in the scope of his employment and riding on the back of a City garbage truck that was stopped on the 6400 block of Silver Spring Drive. The uninsured motorist, who was proceeding westbound on Silver Spring Drive, failed to stop and rear-ended the City vehicle, causing the claimant to fall off the truck and land on the street. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Mr. Phillips sustained an injury to his lower back. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$31,703.04.
