WHEREAS,

O'LYDIA'S BAR & GRILL

*celebrated the fourth anniversary of its opening at 338 S. 1st St. on February 17, 2015;

***WHEREAS,** Situated on the border between Milwaukee's Historic Third Ward and the bustling Fifth Ward, O'Lydia's Bar & Grill was built as a historic Pabst tavern more than a century ago; and*

***WHEREAS,** Coming under the ownership of Linda and Rick Sackett in 2011, O'Lydia's Bar & Grill assumed its new name and a reputation as an Irish-themed sports bar offering patrons shuttle rides to local events; and*

***WHEREAS,** Under the Sacketts' leadership, O'Lydia's Bar & Grill expanded its offerings to include an enhanced menu, "Sunday Funday" brunch and its signature bloody marys, preparing most menu items from scratch in the kitchen; and*

***WHEREAS,** With 16 beers on tap from many local Wisconsin breweries, O'Lydia's Bar & Grill has earned a reputation as a prime location to celebrate spring with its signature open patio and welcoming atmosphere; now, therefore, be it*

***RESOLVED,** That the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee herewith recognizes O'Lydia's Bar & Grill on the occasion of its fourth anniversary and wishes for its continued success; and, be it*
