# ARANCE REPORT

### INVESTIGATIVE NARRATIVE:

This report is written by Detective Joe Groce Of the Criminal Investigation Unit / Internal Affairs Division (CIU/IAD), early power shift.

On Wednesday, August 28, 2002, at 8:30am, this matter was reviewed at the District Attorney's Office by Assistant District Attorney Tom McAdams. Police Officers Andrew GEBHARDT, Charles SEELOW, Keviv CLARK appeared with Attorney Jon CERMELE. Lieutenant Raynard RICHARDS and I were also present, however we did not attend the conference when each officer was intervewed by Assistant District Attorney McAdams. After reviewing this case, Assistant District Attorney McAdams adjournded this matter to a later date.

On Wednsday, September 11, 2002, at 9:00am, this matter was again reviewed by Assistant District Attorney Jon McAdams. After futher review of the circumstances surrounding this matter, Assistant District Attorney McAdams stated there was not enough evidence to support that Officers GEBHARDT or SEELOW battered Ms. QUESTELL. In addition, Assistant District Attorney McAdams stated there was also not enough evidence to support, beyond a reasonable doudt, that Officer GEBHARDT intentionally presented inaccurate information to the Municipal Court regarding the misuse of 9-1-1 citation that he issued to Ms. QUESTELL. Based on these findings, the criminal complaint against Officers GEBHARDT and SEELOW will be closed at this time.
