MPS Tax Hike News Conference Moved To 1 P.M.

Council Members To Hold City Hall News Event to Make Plea For Citizen Unity Against 16.4% Tax Levy Hike Ahead of Tonight's Scheduled MPS Board Vote

Budget amendment deliberations have prompted Milwaukee Common Council members **Ald. Jim Bohl** and **Ald. Bob Donovan** to push back their news conference today to 1 p.m.

Ald. Bohl and Ald. Donovan, who expect to be joined by colleagues during the news conference in the first floor Rotunda at City Hall, 200 E. Wells St., are calling on residents to voice their unified opposition to the MPS superintendent's proposed 16.4% property tax levy increase for next year.

Ald. Bohl said the proposed MPS tax increase is "beyond excessive." "My phone is ringing off the hook with calls from taxpayers outraged with this proposed school tax increase," said Ald. Bohl.
