## REASON FOR REQUEST:

City of Milwaukee Police Office Risa Cain was in the scope of her employment and operating a City of Milwaukee police vehicle that was traveling eastbound on West North Avenue. As the police vehicle approached the intersection of North 11<sup>th</sup> Street and West North Avenue, the uninsured motorist, who was traveling southbound on North 11<sup>th</sup> Street, disregarded the stop sign and struck the police vehicle causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee under Sec. 66.189, Stats, and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Cain sustained injuries to her neck, back and head. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$15,919.21. One of the treating doctors has also indicated that the claimant has a chronic cervical syndrome as a result of the motor vehicle accident. Pursuant to agreement with the claimant, this will be a "Loy" type settlement which will allow the claimant to proceed against American Family Insurance, the personal insurer whose coverage is excess over that provided by the City.
