File Number 071023 is a resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of an Advanced Training Roll Call Law Grant.

Background

- 1. The Wisconsin Department of Justice Training and Standards Bureau, through its Advanced Training Roll Call Law Grant program, makes funds available to law enforcement agencies for initiatives to improve law enforcement training.
- 2. The Milwaukee Police Academy has the professional expertise and technical resources to produce police training videos.
- 3. This is a continuing grant. On November 14, 2006 the Common Council adopted CCFN 060873 that authorized the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) to accept an Advanced Training Roll Call Grant of \$24,500 from the Wisconsin Department of Justice (DOJ).

Discussion

- 1. The Police Department would use this grant to produce training videos relating to search and seizure issues.
- 2. The videos produced by this grant-funded initiative will be used by the Police Department in its own training program. The videos will also be provided to the Wisconsin Law Enforcement Standards Board, which will share the videos with law enforcement agencies across the state.
- 3. The grant period for this project will extend from July 1, 2007, through June 30, 2008.

Fiscal Impact

- 1. The total cost of this grant-funded project is \$25,000, of which 100% will be provided by the grantor, the Wisconsin DOJ. There is no City in-kind or cash match.
- 2. The grant funds will be used to purchase various supplies and materials needed to create police training videos.
