Dear Ms. Kornfehl, Mr. Arenson, Messrs. Arena and Bernstein:


This is to notify you that on June 23, 2006 the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council a suspension of ninety (90) days of the Class "B" Tavern and Tavern Amusement Cabaret (Nite Club) license for the premises located at 618-24 North Broadway ("Jungle") based upon a complaint of Donald S. Arenson seeking revocation of the Class "B" Tavern and Tavern Amusement Cabaret (Nite Club) license.

On June 23, 2006 you were sent a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to the complaint of Mr. Arenson recommending a ninety (90) day suspension of the Class "B" Tavern and Tavern Amusement Cabaret (Nite Club) license. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of July 12, 2006 commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of your right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time and place you did appear, and the licensee did file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee. The licensee was represented by Attorney Andrew Arena 1110 North Old World Third Street, Suite 515, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53203. The complainant, Mr. Donald Arenson, was represented by Attorney Aaron Bernstein, 135 West Wells Street, Suite 340, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53203.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee, the licensee's objections, and the information provided by the complainant, the Common Council adopted the recommendation of the Licenses Committee by a vote of fifteen (15) Ayes and zero (0) Noes to impose upon the Class "B" Tavern and Tavern Amusement Cabaret (Nite Club) license a ninety (90) day suspension.

Said suspension is to be in effect between the date and time of service of this notification and for ninety (90) days thereafter.
