The guy sitting in the truck said the noise would continue until morning. We were left a notice not to use our showers, washers or dishwashers from 10am today until 7am tomorrow. There was no noise warning or mesaaging about no parking or use of city fronts for their equipment. It is late and many of us work first thing. The level of noise would not be tolerable to most normal people. With proper notice I couldd have slept elsewhere although this may not be true for all. Why is noisy work done on 3rd shift? Shouldn't the warnings include all necessary information and offer drinking water to the local households with the warning to not use water?
