

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

This is in response to a request from our traffic signal engineering staff to prohibit the south crosswalk at the intersection of North 6th Street at West McKinley Avenue.

Our traffic engineering staff has investigated this request and found that the southwest corner of this intersection does not line up with the southeast corner. Thus, pedestrians crossing westbound in the south crosswalk would finish up in the eastbound driving lane. Therefore, in the interest of public safety, we recommend prohibiting this crossing.

We will prepare the necessary legislation for the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so that you may support it to final passage.


