This link was helpful. I am sympathetic to the need for a storm door and the desire for a tight fit to be effective in WI weather, however all 3 of my storms at 140 E. Vine Street are wood and more appropriate to the historic character of the neighborhood. I believe that it is possible to find wood storm doors and to have them appropriately installed by a skilled carpenter to achieve the necessary fit. I do not believe it creates an unnecessary burden or unnecessarily unwieldy expense to maintain compliance and to protect the historic character of the neighborhood.
