Our on-going crash identification and surveillance program indicated a need to investigate the above-captioned intersection for control change. Our findings show that three crashes have been reported to the Milwaukee Police Department in eleven months. Our inspection revealed that a sight obstruction on the southeast corner reduces the available safe approach speed. We, therefore, recommend the above-captioned traffic control change.
