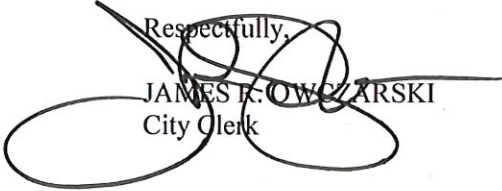
Dear Mrs. Maria Guadalupe Cabral Villarreal:

("EL PARAISO").

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee, the Common Council voted to renew with a 10 (ten) day suspension your Food Dealer and Food Peddler licenses based upon the preponderance of the evidence in the aldermanic, applicant, and City Departments testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to the health, safety or welfare of the public for the illegal parking, pending citations, and failure to comply with the approved plan of operations. Said suspension is in effect between 12:01 a.m. on June 02, 2026 until 11:59 p.m. on June 11, 2026.
