WHEREAS, *Mark Huber was employed by Aurora Health Care for more than 30 years and progressively advanced his scope of service and responsibility to his (final) enterprise role as SVP, Community Health and Engagement; and*

WHEREAS, *Mark Huber created Aurora Health Care's first community health needs assessment study in Sheboygan in 1993, one of the first formal CHNAs in the nation, establishing a process that was adopted by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) in the formation of rules for the Affordable Care Act; and*

WHEREAS, *Mark Huber's leadership provided key support in the development of numerous community partnerships to improve access to care and meet needs in underserved communities, including the creation of new community-based free clinics, school-based health clinics, and FQHC partnerships across Wisconsin; and*

WHEREAS, *Mark Huber administered the development and expansion of the Aurora Healing and Advocacy Services program to help survivors of sexual assault heal, including being a founder of the Healing Center in Milwaukee; now, therefore, be it*
