5. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

A previous approval was received from Historic Preservation to remove the 4x8 plywood covering over the upper portion of the facade. The determination was made that it was preferable to recreate the Art Deco version of the facade rather than go back further to a brick masonry exterior as very little of the original exterior material and openings remained after previous renovations. The Art Deco facade was create with a Vitrolite glass tile that we have determined after extensive searches, we will not be able to find that material for a recreation. As an alternative, we are proposing an architectural panel system that would have panel joints replicate the shapes of the Vitrolite tiles. We are proposing a color called "Crafted White" which has a varied tone with areas that shimmer light differently so as to not create a flat, monochromatic face that would lack the depth of a glass tile. An alternative to this would be to use a solid off-white shade (on the pink-ish side) for the architectural panels and focus less on an attempt to look like glazed panels but still maintain the joint pattern of the original Art Deco facade. The round windows and vertical glass block band would be visible again as architectural elements in the finished renovation.

When the western portion of the facade was exposed there was a cast stone material found to have been installed over the original masonry. We have found there is no feasible way to remove this product. We are proposing to install windows within the entire recessed panel area of the facade so the exposed stone facing would be substantially reduced in it's prominence.

Samples of the proposed panel system have been provided.
