Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. On Sunday, September 25th, 2022 at 5:02pm, Officer Thomas KRESA and I, Squad 6240, were dispatched to investigate a sexual assault complaint at 3378 S. Howell Av. in the City and County of Milwaukee. The caller stated, she was sexually assaulted at 4:00am at the C-viche restaurant, 2165 S. Kinnickinnic Av. and that the suspect is her first cousin and the owner of Ceviche Restaurant.

Upon arrival, I spoke to the victim, M. U-G. who is a Spanish speaker. M. stated on Sunday, September 25th at approximately 4:00am, she and a few family members went to the C-viche restaurant after a night of dancing at a local night club. M. stated she had been drinking heavily that night and when she got to restaurant was nauseated.

M. stated among her family members who were at C-viche, there was the owner, Karlos SARIANO and one of his waitresses (Sophia). M. stated Karlos is actually a first cousin whom she lives with and works at another restaurant he owns selling tacos.

M. stated that while at C-viche, Karlos gave her a beer but she did not drink it. M. stated at one point she and Sophia went into the bathroom because they were feeling nauseous. When they came out of the bathroom they noticed everyone had left except the owner Karlos.

M. stated while at the restaurant she noticed Sophia and Karlos making out. A short while later she realized Sophia had left the restaurant and she was now alone with Karlos. M. stated that while at the restaurant, she had penis to vagina intercourse and penis to Anus intercourse with Karlos. She stated she was afraid to speak up because Karlos was her older cousin. M. stated she protested during the penis to anus intercourse because it was hurting her.

M. stated after they had intercourse, Karlos drove her to her sisters boyfriends house in the city of Cudahy where they argued. M. then was driven back to Karlos residence. M. stated she was finally able to leave Karlos's residence safely that morning and file a police report by the afternoon.

It should be noted the Manager on duty, "Madison" began to argue with police, requesting us to return at a later date for the photographs. Madison, who we had advised earlier that afternoon of our intentions, expressed no concern at that time.

14 Digital Photographs of the scene were taken while the restaurant was empty of customers and took less then 2 minutes. Madison continued to argue with officer KRESA and I about the attitude of Police in general as we left the premise.

You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
