Christopher G. Neal, by his attorney Alan D. Eisenberg, submits the following as and for his Notice of Claim for Damages:

- 1. On or about May 29, 2002 at or about 1:55 p.m., 8 unknown and unidentified Milwaukee Police Officers from MPD District 7 entered onto the locked fenced-in premises of Claimant without Claimant's knowledge or permission, at which Claimant's 6-year old American Pit Bull Terrier, "Cody" was in the yard; one of the officers reached over the fence and Cody bit that officer on the lower arm;
- 2. On or about May 29, 2002 at or about 1:55 p.m., unknown Milwaukee Police Officers from MPD District 7 recklessly and brutally fired five shots into said animal, mortally wounding Cody;
- 3. On or about May 29, 2002 at or about 3:20 p.m., Claimant arrived at home to find eight MPD Police Officers lounging about in Claimant's yard without Claimant's knowledge or permission and discovered to his horror that his pet dog, Cody, was dead;
- 4. On or about May 29, 2002 at or about 3:20 p.m., Claimant requested the remains of Cody so that Claimant could attend to an appropriate interment of the animal; MPD Police Officers and Officials refused Claimant's request for return of the remains;
- 5. On or about May 29, 2002 at or about 3:20 p.m., Claimant had learned that MPD Police Officers and Officials had carelessly and brutally discarded the remains of Cody, throwing the animal in a metal garbage can and carried the animal to an unknown location;
- 6. On or about May 29, 2002 at or about 6:15 p.m., Claimant requested of the attending officers and officials a copy of incident report concerning this matter and was told, "that is police business only."

ON WEDNEDAY MAY 29, ABOUT 1.30 PM, I WAS STANDING ON MY PORCH WHEN IS SAW A GROUP OF POLICE ON CHAMBERS, STORMED NORTH ON 40TH ST, 3000 BLOCK AND ARRESTED TWO YOUNG MEN AT 3024 NO 40TH ST

ONE OF THE ARRESTEING OFFICERS WAS BITTEN BY THE FAMILY PET WHEN HE REACHES OVER THE GATE TO GRAB THE YOUNG MAN.

WHILE THE THIS OFFICER WAS AWAITING FOR TREAMENT ANOTHER OFFICER CAME TO OUR PORCH ASK FOR THE OWNERS NAME, WHERE SHE WAS AND DID WE HAVE THE NUMBER AND HER AGE.

MY FATHER ASKED THE OFFICER TWICE NOT TO SHOOT THE DOG AND WAIT UNTIL THE DOG OWNER GETS HOME

FOR THE NEXT HOUR AND A HALF THE POLICE OFFICERS WERE IN THE SURROUNDING YARDS AND ALLEYS, PICKING UP TOMATO RACKS THROWING THEM AT THE DOG. THEN SPRAYED FIRE EXTINGUISHER AT THE DOG, THEY WERE BANGING AND HITTING THE FENCE WITH STICKS. DURING ALL THIS TIME THE DOG SAT AT THE SOUTH EAST CORNER OF THE HOUSE NEAR THE PATIO LAYING DOWN CALMLY.

THEN APPROXIAMATELY 2. 50 PM, ABOUT 7 POLICEMAN AND THE DOG CATCHER ENTERS THE YARD THEY MOVE ALONG THE SIDE WALK TO THE BACK OF THE HOUSE, THE DOG WAS IN NON AGGRESSIVE, SITTING POSITION ON HIS BACK LEGS BARKING, THEN THE RAISES HIMSELF TO ALL FOUR LEGS AND ONE OF THE POLICE OFFICERS SHOT ABOUT 5 OR 6 TIMES.

ON WEDNEDAY MAY 29, ABOUT 1.30 PM, I WAS STANDING ON MY PORCH WHEN IS SAW A GROUP OF POLICE ON CHAMBERS, STORMED NORTH ON 40TH ST, 3000 BLOCK AND ARRESTED TWO YOUNG MEN AT 3024 NO 40TH ST. THE POLICE OFFICERS WE SO AGGRESSIVE. I FELT AS IF THEY MAY HAVE SHOT THE YOUNG MAN IF HAD NOT BEEN STANDING THERE WATCHING THEM.

ONE OF THE ARRESTEING OFFICERS WAS BITTEN BY THE FAMILY PET WHEN HE REACHES OVER THE GATE TO GRAB THE YOUNG MAN.

ONCE THE YOUNG MEN WERE PUT IN TO SQUAD CAR, THE POLICE OFFICERS STARTED TO GO AFTER THE DOG THAT HAD BITTEN THE OFFICER.

ONE OF THE OFFICERS WANTED TO KNOW IF THE DOG WOULD BITE. I REPLIED, I DON'T KNOW, I WOULD TRUST ANY DOG.

ANOTHER OFFICER WANTED TO KNOT IF THE DOG HAD HIS SHOTS. I REPLIED I, DON'T KNOW, THE OWNER WILL BE HOME SOON AND SHE CAN GIVE YOU ALL THIS INFORMATION.

ANOTHER OFFICER ASKS ME THE NAME OF THE DOG OWNER AND HER AGE. AND I GAVE HIM THIS INFORMATION AND TOLD HIM ANY OTHER INFORMATION THAT HE WANTED TO KNOW ABOUT HER, HE SHOULD WAIT UNTIL SHE GET HOME AND ASK HER. I ASKED THEM SEVERAL TIMES NOT TO SHOOT THE DOG, THE HOME OWNER WOULD BE HOME SOON. SHE CAN TURN THE DOG OVER TO YOU.

FOR THE NEXT APPROXIMATELY HOUR AND A HALF THE POLICE OFFICERS, HUMAIN SOCIETY AND MADDAC CONTINUED TRYING TO COLLECT THE DOG. I SAW POLICE OFFICERS AND OTHERS WITH POLE WITH LOOPES ON THE END AND FIRE EXTINGUISHERS. THEY WERE IN THE YARD OF THE HOME ON THE NORTH AND SOUTH IN THE ALLEY AND IN FRONTS THE HOME AT 3024 N 40^{TH} .

THEN AT ABOUT 2.55 PM, I HERD ABOUT 5 OR 6 SHOTS AND WENT INTO BACK YARD AND SAW THE DOG LYING ON HIS RIGHT SIDE CLOSE TO THE FENCE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE YARD.

A LADY OFFICER SAID TYREE WOULD NOT CALL THE DOG AND WOULD NOT CALL THE DOG OWNER AND WE WAITED AND WAITED
