**WHEREAS,** *Alice Lawrence was a woman of constant motion and remarkable versatility, and in her youth was a participant in Majorettes, Drill Team, Track, Bowling, Softball, and Choir, and this energy and drive would define her professional life; and*

**WHEREAS,** *Alice Lawrence began her career with the City of Milwaukee in 1988 at a time when women were a rarity among field staff, originally starting in Forestry for the Department of Public Works, she moved to Electrical Services in her second year of service and received her first promotion to the position of Electrical Services Laborer in 1993, and was promoted to the position of Electrical Worker in 1998, and in 2007 she received another promotion to Office Assistant IV where she helped guide the department through various transitions before her retirement in 2020; and*

**WHEREAS,** *Alice Lawrence leaves behind to cherish her memory her husband, one son, seven grandchildren, and two great-grandchildren, as well as countless individuals on whom she had a significant impact and who will remember her fondly; now, therefore, be it*
