Dear Alderman Bohl:

This is in response to a request we received from Alderman Nardelli to install the above-captioned traffic control restriction.

Due to safety concerns with traffic entering the Fond du Lac Freeway (STH 145), we believe that the 25 Miles Per Hour speed limit currently in effect is too low to allow safe merging with freeway traffic. Additionally, the roadway is constructed with a rural type cross-section, and abutting land use consists primarily of parkland, wetland, and open space. State Statutes also suggest a higher speed limit for a roadway of this character. We, therefore, recommend that the speed limit be increased from the existing 25 Miles Per Hour to 35 Miles Per Hour.

We will prepare the necessary legislation for the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so that you may support it to final passage.

This is in response to a request we received from Ms. Zora Fanroy to install the above-captioned traffic control restriction.

Our Traffic Engineering staff has investigated this request and found that the accident data received from the Milwaukee Police Department revealed an increase in accidents at this intersection that would warrant the above-captioned control. Our inspection of the intersection revealed that approaching motorists must reduce their vehicle speed to 13 miles per hour to enter the intersection safely. We, therefore, concur that the present yield signs appear to be no longer effective, and will recommend the installation of stop signs.

We will prepare the necessary legislation for the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so that you may support it to final passage.
