File #051254 is a resolution authorizing and directing the Commissioner of Public Works to execute a project agreement with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation for median island reconfiguration and alteration and the installation of a traffic signal at the intersection of West Vliet Street and North 40<sup>th</sup> Street in the 10<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> Aldermanic Districts under the Hazard Elimination Safety Project.

## **BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION**

- 1. This resolution authorizes and directs the Commissioner of Public Works to execute a project agreement with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT) for median island reconfiguration and alteration and the installation of a traffic signal using Hazard Elimination Safety Program funds.
- 2. The department reviewed the intersection of West Vliet Street and North 40<sup>th</sup> Street and determined that there were a high number of crashes involving angle accidents. The proposed recommended improvements include removal of NE bound bypass, lengthening of EB left turn lane on Vliet Street, widening of the SB approach on 40<sup>th</sup> Street, island modifications and signal installation.
- 3. The total cost for design and construction is \$196,899. The estimated breakdown of funding for the project includes:

4. The expected completion date is in 2008.

### FISCAL IMPACT

- 1. The total for the Hazard Elimination Safety Program is \$196,899.00 in funding. The grantor share is providing \$177,209.10, 90%, and the City share is providing \$19,689.90, 10%.
- 2. The City funding is through the **2006** capital improvements fund, the Paving Program-Street Reconstruction-City Contribution to State and Federally Aided Projects.
