Scope: In-depth review of suburban overdose fatalities to develop local recommendations

Scope: Using a Trauma Informed Care framework to tackle opioid prevalence by collaborating across the South Shore communities
Current Initiatives: (1) Utilizing & reviewing real-time reporting of overdoses through OD Map; (2) Trauma Informed Care training for all Health Department, Fire, and Police staff; (3) Quick Response Team; (4) Media Campaign
