The Health Department is submitting the following grant resolution for Common Council approval.

<u>Bioterrorism Focus B Grant</u> - This continuing grant funded by the Centers for Disease Control through the State of Wisconsin Division of Health and Family Services will enhance local public health agency capacity to prepare and respond to Bioterrorism.

Breast Cancer Awareness Grant - This funding from the Wisconsin Division of Health and Family Services will be used to expand the scope of the Wisconsin Women's Cancer Control Program beyond its current focus of breast and cervical cancer screening to include health promotion and risk reduction for cardiovascular disease, osteoporosis, diabetes, mental illness and domestic violence.

2005 Consolidated Contract - This continuing contract from the Wisconsin Division of Health and Family Services includes six initiatives, each having a specific purpose and target population. The six initiatives are: Adolescent School Health Program, Well Women Breast and Cervical Cancer Control Program, the Immunization Action Plan Grant, Preventive Health Grant, Childhood Lead Detection Grant and the Bioterrorism Focus A Grant. Changes to the Positions Ordinance are incorporated in this funding.
