

AMENDMENT TO INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
THE CITY OF MILWAUKEE  
AND  
THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM

Amendment dated this \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2001 to the Indemnification Agreement between the City of Milwaukee (City), a municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Wisconsin and the Employees' Retirement System of the City of Milwaukee (MERS), a body corporate and politic organized and existing under the laws of the State of Wisconsin and the ordinances of the City of Milwaukee, dated June 30, 1992, as amended.

The City and MERS entered into an agreement of indemnification dated June 30, 1992, with the City as "Indemnitor" and MERS, the Annuity and Pension Board of MERS and each individual of the Board while acting in his or her capacity collectively referred to as "Indemnitee," through December 31, 1999.

Whereas, on December 22, 1999, the parties amended and supplemented this Agreement and extended the Agreement through December 31, 2000; and

Whereas, on December 31, 2000, the parties extended this Agreement, as amended and supplemented, through December 31, 2001.

Whereas, the parties to this Agreement wish to extend the Agreement, as amended and supplemented, to December 31, 2003;

Now, therefore, in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties, the parties agree that the Agreement dated June 30, 1992, as amended and supplemented on December 22, 1999, is extended to continue in effect pursuant to its terms and conditions through December 31, 2003.
