Subject: data center feedback
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As a Milwaukee resident, I do not support adding a data center. There is a wealth of information on the impact of data centers on a community and IT IS NOT GOOD.

- Negative impacts on fresh water usages - this is our greatest resource - clean drinking water, tourism, etc. Previous bodies of water in Beaver Dam were ruined by the data center within months of construction.
- Passed on expenses through higher WE energy costs and pressure on an already fickle electricity system (especially for families in the city proper).
